Description of Project

The purpose of this project was to create a secondary or post-secondary school. Students were required to develop a mission statement, motto, and general layout of a school.

Statement of Collaboration

This project transpired during the fall semester in 2009. Communication among the participants occurred during allotted class time, email correspondence, and synchronous meetings off campus. With the guidance of Dr. Meskill and required class readings the team members created a hypothetical post-secondary school situated in the Luther Forest Technology Campus. The members named the school The Progressive Junior College of New York (PJCNY) which specialized in technology and the applied sciences. Each member was responsible for a different aspect of the school's development; Jen focused on the web page development and school demographics, Liza development the mission, and Shelli developed the motto. Upon each member's completion of said aspect of the design, the team members met to provide peer review and revise as necessary. The remainder of the project - school design, layout, faculty, degree programs, etc. – was developed collaboratively during team meetings. The final facet of the collaboration required the team members to create a 10 minute presentation of the school to the remaining class members. The team each shared their respective contributions during the presentation. The team collaboration resulted in a finished product that was well received by other class members as well as Dr. Meskill.


We agree all members participated fully and worked cooperatively on this product.
